- Games will consist of two 20-minute halves with a 5-minute halftime
- Points will be awarded in the following way: win = 3, loss = 1
- Each game must conclude with a winner declared
- If the game is tied at its conclusion, the winner will be decided by penalty

kicks. Only the players present on the field at the conclusion of the game at

regular time may take the penalty kicks. Each team will have 5 penalty kicks.

If still tied, penalty kicks will continue into sudden death. A win by penalty kicks will be considered as one additional goal (i.e. if teams are tied 2-2 at

regulation time and the penalty shootout results in a 5-3 score, the final game result will be recorded as 3-2, not 7-5).

- Games will be recorded on paper game sheets provided at the fields
- All other Lakeshore League rules apply

The winner of each pool will be determined in the following way: a) Total Points

- b) If tied, total goals against
- c) If tied, total goals for
- d) If tied, coin toss.

Player Equipment and Safety
